

David Lefebvre is a former veterinary practitioner with a PhD in Veterinary Sciences. In 2009 he joined the Veterinary and Agrochemical Research Centre (CODA-CERVA), which is nowadays part of Sciensano in Brussels, Belgium. David Lefebvre is a member of the Service for Exotic and vector-borne diseases and he responsible for the Belgian National Reference Laboratory (NRL) for foot-and-mouth disease (FMD), swine vesicular disease (SVD) and vesicular stomatitis (VS), which also acts as a WOAH Collaborating Centre for validation, quality assessment and quality control of diagnostic assays and vaccine testing for vesicular diseases in Europe and as an FAO Reference Centre for vesicular diseases. Since January 1st 2019, the Service for Exotic and vector-borne diseases also acts as the European Union Reference Laboratory for FMD, together with ANSES (Maisons-Alfort, France).
